The Young Environmentalist Academy (YEA) is a program provided by Pride of Bertie and is available for middle students.

All adults consisting of conservation coaches and staff involved in the program are thoroughly screened and will have completed a background check before working with your child to ensure their safety during encounter within and outside of the school building. Conservation coaches will also receive training to lay the foundation for a successful program with safety as our top priority as well as clarify roles, boundaries, expectations.

The YEA conservation coaches are required to report any minor (under 18 years of age), who is currently endangered by abuse or neglect, and to report if children are suspected of being a danger to themselves or others.

In permitting your child to participate in YEA program, you understand that Pride of Bertie is authorized to release or exchange any relevant information with its partners for reporting purposes alone.

I understand that participation in this program for my child and all events associated are highly recommended, but voluntary. Participation in the program may be canceled at any time with written request by the parent on record.
